Selection for admission to Master's and Doctoral programs in 2025/1

- The Coordination of the Postgraduate Program in History (PPGH) of the School of Humanities of the Pontifical Catholic University of Rio Grande do Sul (PUCRS) publishes the rules of the Selection Process number 01/2025 for admission in the first academic semester of 2025/1, at the Master's and Doctorate levels, in accordance with the requirements of the Program Regulations and the Statutes and General Regulations of the University.
- 2. The Program, concept 5 in the Coordination of Superior Level Staff Improvement (CAPES), has a concentration area called History of Iberian and American Societies.

The program has the following lines of research: Politics, Intellectuals and the Media; Culture and Ethnicity; and Society, Economic Development and Migration.

Eligibility

All holders of undergraduate diplomas, duly recognized by the Ministry of Education (MEC) or by the competent body of the country of origin, in History or in related areas, as well as undergraduate graduates, may participate in the Selection Process for the Master's Degree, provided that they can prove the conclusion of said course, on a date prior to enrollment in the Postgraduate Program. Likewise, all holders of Bachelor's and Master's degrees in History or related areas, duly recognized and recommended by MEC/CAPES or by the competent body in their country of origin, as well as Master's degree graduates, may take part in the Doctorate Selection Process, provided they can prove that they have completed the course before enrolling in the Doctorate.



Places for students

This selection aims to fill up to 12 vacancies at Master's level and up to 12 vacancies at Doctorate level. In addition to the 12 (twelve) places on offer at Master's level, 01 (one) place will be offered to foreign candidates and 01 (one) place will be offered to self-declared black, brown or indigenous candidates. Likewise, in addition to the 12 (twelve) places on offer at Doctorate level, 01 (one) place will be offered to foreign candidates and 01 (one) place will be offered to self-declared black, brown or indigenous candidates.

If there are no candidates who meet the selection requirements, the places allocated to these candidates may be filled by other non-foreign candidates and self-declared black, brown or indigenous candidates.

3. Registration

Registration will take place exclusively on the Internet via the following link: <u>https://webapp.pucrs.br/inscricao-stricto/#/login</u>between 01/09/24 and 25/11/2024.

After completing the online registration form, the candidate must pay the registration fee of R\$ 100,00.

3. Documents

When registering *online*, you must *upload* the documents specified below.

- 3.1. Identity card or, in the case of foreigners, passport or National Foreigner Registration (RNE);
- 3.2. Individual Taxpayer Registration (CPF) (only for Brazilians);
- 3.3. Lattes/CNPq CV (<u>http://lattes.cnpq.br</u>). If foreign candidate, *Curriculum Vitae;*
- 3.4. Bachelor's and/or Master's degree diploma (the latter only for PhD candidates who already have a Master's degree) or proof that you will complete your Bachelor's or Master's degree by the date of enrollment;

Note: Candidates who only present the official declaration of completion of their Bachelor's or Master's degree, issued by their university of origin, if selected, will have to present a copy of their Bachelor's or Master's degree diploma at their first registration. If you do not provide this documentation at the time of registration, you will lose your place.



- 3.5. Copy of the academic transcript of the Bachelor's and/or Master's degree (the latter only for PhD candidates who already have a Master's degree);
- 3.6. Candidates with disabilities or special educational needs who require specific assistance or adapted material must attach a recent report (maximum 12 months) to the documentation, issued and signed by a specialist accredited by the Regional Medical Council (CRM). The document must specify the nature, type and degree of disability, as well as the conditions recommended for carrying out the assessment activities provided for in this Notice.
- 3.7. Master's or Doctorate Research Project, according to the model indicated on the Program page.

6. The Selection Process

6.1. The Selection Committee

The Selection Committee for the Master's and Doctorate programs will be constituted by Research Line, with the participation of all permanent and collaborating professors linked to them.

6.2. Stages of the Selection Process

STAGE 1 - Analysis of the relevant documentation: eliminatory only;

STAGE 2 - Research Project (Master's and Doctorate): eliminatory and classification;

STAGE 3 - Interview by Line of Research: eliminatory and qualifying. All interviews will be held by videoconference, with the date and time announced on the Program's website.

6.3. Selection Criteria

STAGE 1:

a) After checking the relevant documentation, candidates who fail to send any of the documents required above will be eliminated.

b) The list of successful candidates will be published on the wate https://portal.pucrs.br/ensino/cursos/mestrado/historia-2/

STEP 2:

a) The preliminary evaluation of the Research Project (for Master's and Doctorate) will be carried out by each of the professors of the Research Line indicated by the candidate at the time of registration, by means of a spreadsheet with standardized

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criteria available at <u>https://portal.pucrs.br/ensino/cursos/mestrado/historia-2/</u> and marks from 0 (zero) to 10.0 (ten) will be awarded for each item. Those who, considering the average of the marks given by each professor to the Research Project, obtain an average equal to or greater than 6.0 (six) will be considered for the next stage, this mark being called Average 1 (M1).

STEP 3:

a) Individual interview of candidates by videoconference with all the professors of the Research Line indicated at the time of application, according to standardized criteria indicated in a spreadsheet available at <u>https://portal.pucrs.br/ensino/cursos/mestrado/historia-2/</u>. The Master's and Doctorate interviews will take place on a different day, time and place, as indicated in item 9 of this Notice.

b) Candidates will be duly informed by the secretariat of the access data to the interview on the videoconferencing platform, according to the schedule made by each Research Line.

6.4. Final ranking

Considering the grade called M1 and the average of the grades given by each professor for the interview, here called Average 2 (M2), the student who obtains an average of 6.0 (six) or higher will be considered approved to enter the PPGH, in the Master's or Doctorate courses.

Places on the Master's and Doctorate courses will be filled up to the limit set by this Notice. Candidates who have been approved in a position higher than the limit of places established here will be considered alternates, and may be called in the event of other better-ranked candidates withdrawing.

The candidates classified for entry to the Master's and Doctorate courses will be published separately, in descending order of their final arithmetic average, identified on the PPGH website exclusively by their registration code, without nominal reference.

7. Results of the Selection Process
